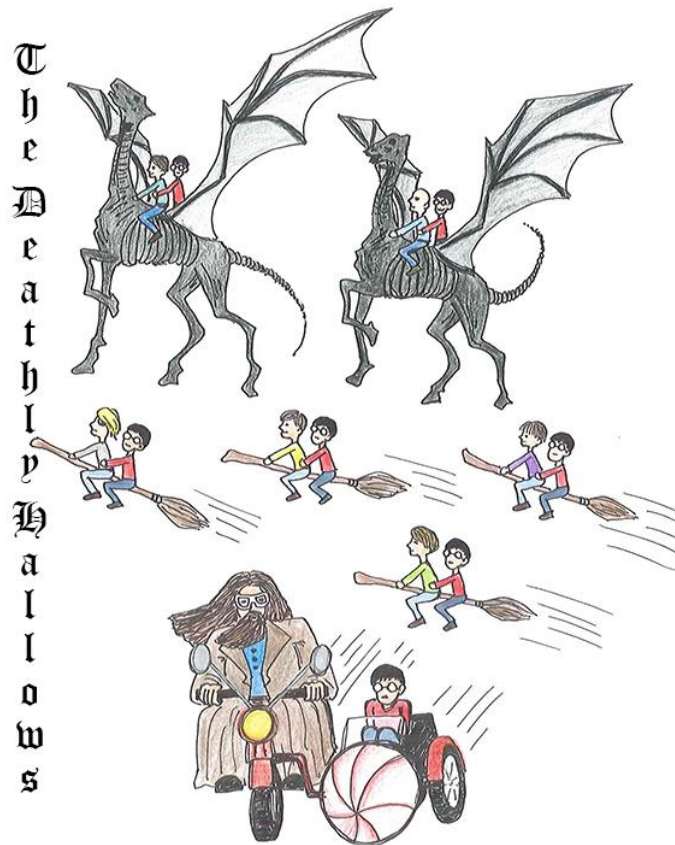

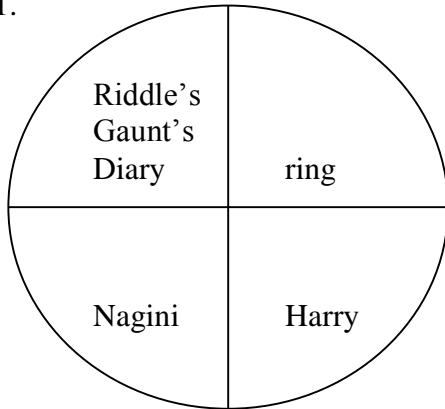
You will encounter these people and objects again as Harry continues on his mission to destroy Voldemort. Think about the potential roles each may play in Harry’s future.

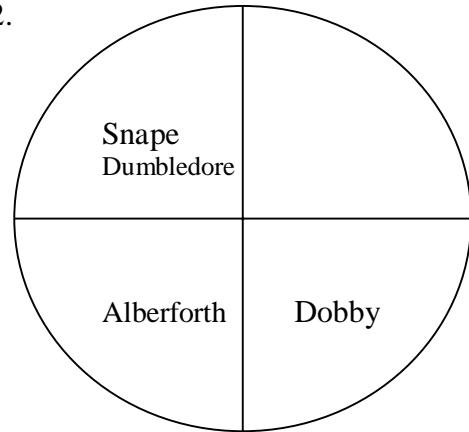

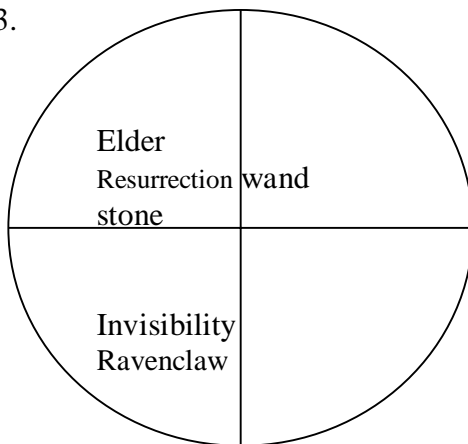

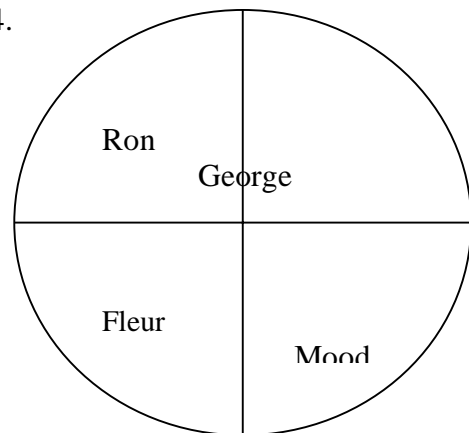

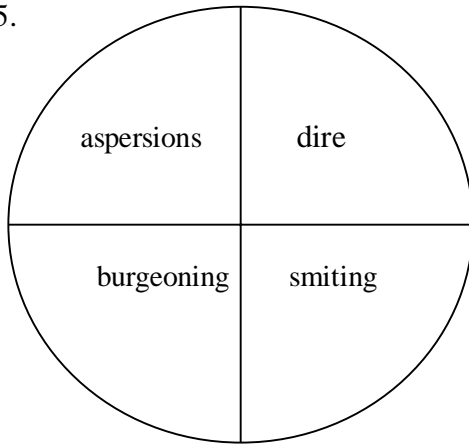

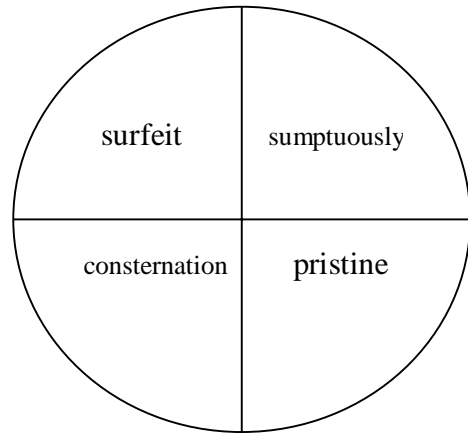

Student Directions: After reading the book, review the actions and identify what each action reveals about the character’s beliefs.

Action	Belief
Harry tells Neville to make sure Nagini is killed.	
Harry made a pact with a goblin, Griphook, to give him the Gryffindor sword.	
Harry, Ron, and Hermione want to see Luna’s father, Lovegood, to find out about the symbol on Grindelwald’s tomb.	
Disguised, Harry and his friends went to the Ministry of Magic to find Umbridge.	
Snape killed Dumbledore.	
Voldemort killed Snape.	
Harry asked Dumbledore when he appeared in his portrait, if it was right to leave the Snitch and Elder Wand unused.
