

Alphabet Bingo

What is "Alphabet Bingo" and why is it important?

"Alphabet Bingo" is a game that encourages your child to practice matching upper case letters to the corresponding lower case letters. With this game, children also can practice the sounds that each letter makes.

How can I use "Alphabet Bingo" with my child?

Letter Identification: This game can be played by one child or a group of children. Use the attached letter cards and Bingo sheet to play this game. Print a capital letter in each square on the Bingo cards. Call out a letter of the alphabet in random order. Have your child (or children) complete his card by listening for the letter, finding the lower case letter card, and placing it on the correct capital letter. When the child completes the row, have him say the name of each letter in the completed row. Reverse roles in the game by having your child call out the letter and check to see if you are correct.

Sound Identification: Use the same method to practice sounds. Call out a sound that a letter makes in random order. Have the children complete their cards by listening for the sound, finding the lower case letter card that makes that sound, and placing it on the correct capital letter. When the child completes the row, have him say the name and sound of each letter in the completed row.

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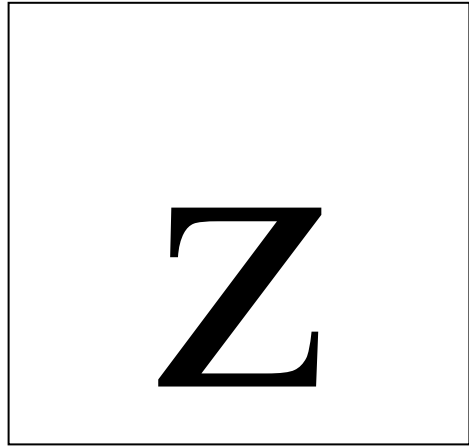
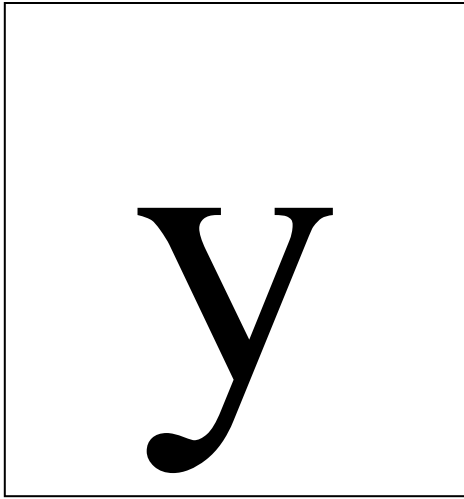
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
