






Word Bingo

What is "Word Bingo" and why is it important?

"Word Bingo" is a game that encourages your child to practice identifying sight words and words with specific letter/sound combinations that he is learning.

How can I use "Word Bingo" with my child?

This game can be played with one or more children. Use word cards from your child's "Word Bank." To play, you will also need to create Bingo sheets. Select nine words from the word cards and print them on a Bingo sheet. Print some different words on each Bingo sheet used. Randomly call out a word from the pack of word cards. Have your child complete his card by listening for the word and placing a marker on the Bingo sheet if he hears a match. When your child completes a row horizontally, vertically, or diagonally he calls "Bingo." Have him read the words on the sheet in order to win.
