

Autograph Reading

What is “Autograph Reading” and why is it important?

"Autograph Reading" is a strategy to help your child become a fluent reader by encouraging him to read passages several times. Rereading text will help your child recognize words automatically, which is an important step in becoming a good reader.

How can I use “Autograph Reading” with my child?

Your child can use "Autograph Reading" with any text of his choice. However, it is especially important to use the strategy with Structured Language Experience Stories and Decodable Books so your child has repeated practice in reading text containing specific words and spelling patterns that he is learning. Your child should read a text to a varied audience (at least five people) throughout the day. Each listener should sign the autograph sheet indicating that the text was read aloud. Autograph sheets can be attached to the passage and laminated for reuse. The passages should be saved and reread periodically for practice.
