

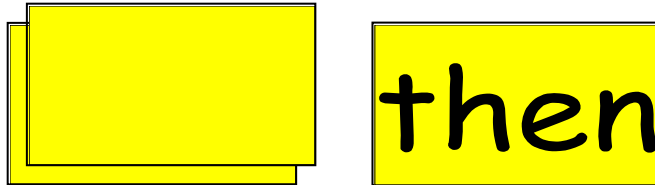
Word Football

What is “Word Football” and why is it important?

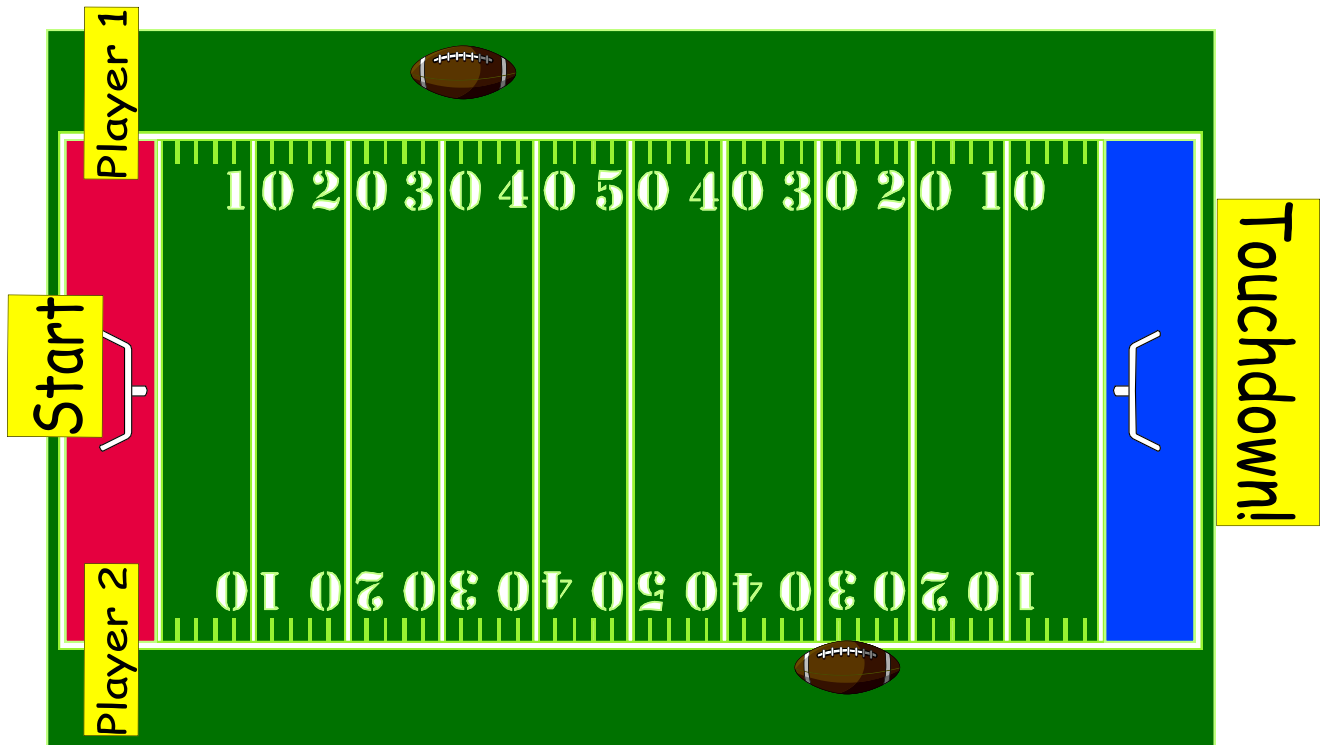
"Word Football" is a game you can play with your child to help him master common sight words.

How can I use “Word Football” with my child?

This is a game that your child can play with you or with another child. The two players start at the end of a football field form which is marked off every ten yards. Each player takes a turn selecting a card from a stack of sight words. If your child reads the card correctly, he may advance ten yards. A chip or token can be used to mark the yards. If the word is not read correctly, your child may not advance. Players take turns selecting and reading sight word cards. The first person to score a “touchdown” wins.
