

Literary Poster

What is a Literary Poster and why is it important?

A Literary Poster is a creative way for students to showcase their interpretation of a text. Students can design a Wanted Poster, a Reward Poster, or any other kind of poster that is relevant to the story.

How can I use a Literary Poster with my students?

Show students examples of different types of posters, including Reward Posters, Want Ads, and Wanted Posters; discuss how they relate to events in a story. Tell students that they will be designing a poster to go along with a story they just finished. It can be any kind as long as it shows their understanding of the story and includes relevant vocabulary words. (Encourage students to use newly learned vocabulary words to increase their understanding of the words.) Afterward, invite students to share their posters with the class, describing and discussing them in relation to the story. Following is an example of a Wanted Poster for “Goldilocks and the Three Bears.”
